## Other Scriptures:

Deuteronomy 31:8

He goes before us to lead so we will know where to go and not wander. He prepares our way and path and walks with us.

Psalm 25:12

It is the one who fears the Lord that He will guide and direct. If we are disobedient, He will not guide knowing we don't listen. The one who fears the Lord is instructed by His Word and the Lord confides by revealing His covenant with us.

Psalm 37:23

The person whom God delights is the one God watches over and makes firm the steps He takes. The word "steps" in this verse refers to his course of life.

Psalm 48:14

He is our guide all our lives even to the end. In other words, His promise is to never leave or forsake us.

**God's promise not to be silent when we need guidance and direction. He will direct us in the way to go.**

**Isaiah 42:16**

**When we don't know which direction to go or turn, we may feel we are as a blind person because we cannot see the way. His promise is not to allow us to stumble around but to guide us on our path and the darkness in front will be as light.**
