debtors.

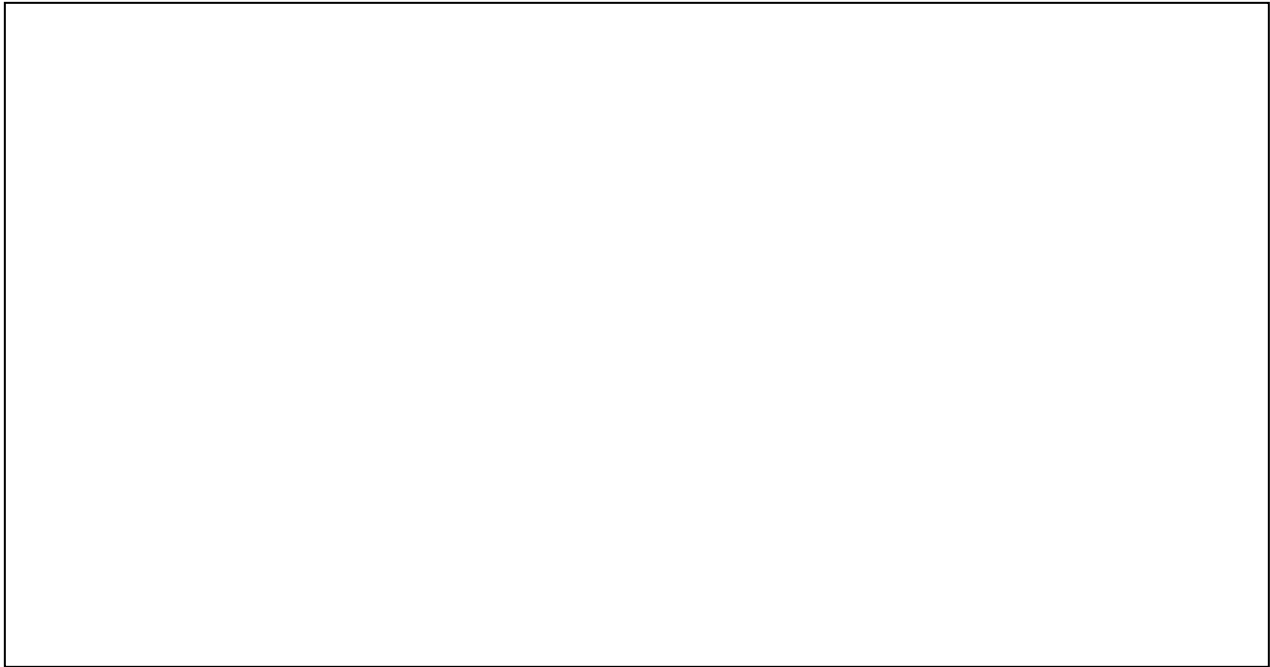
And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.”

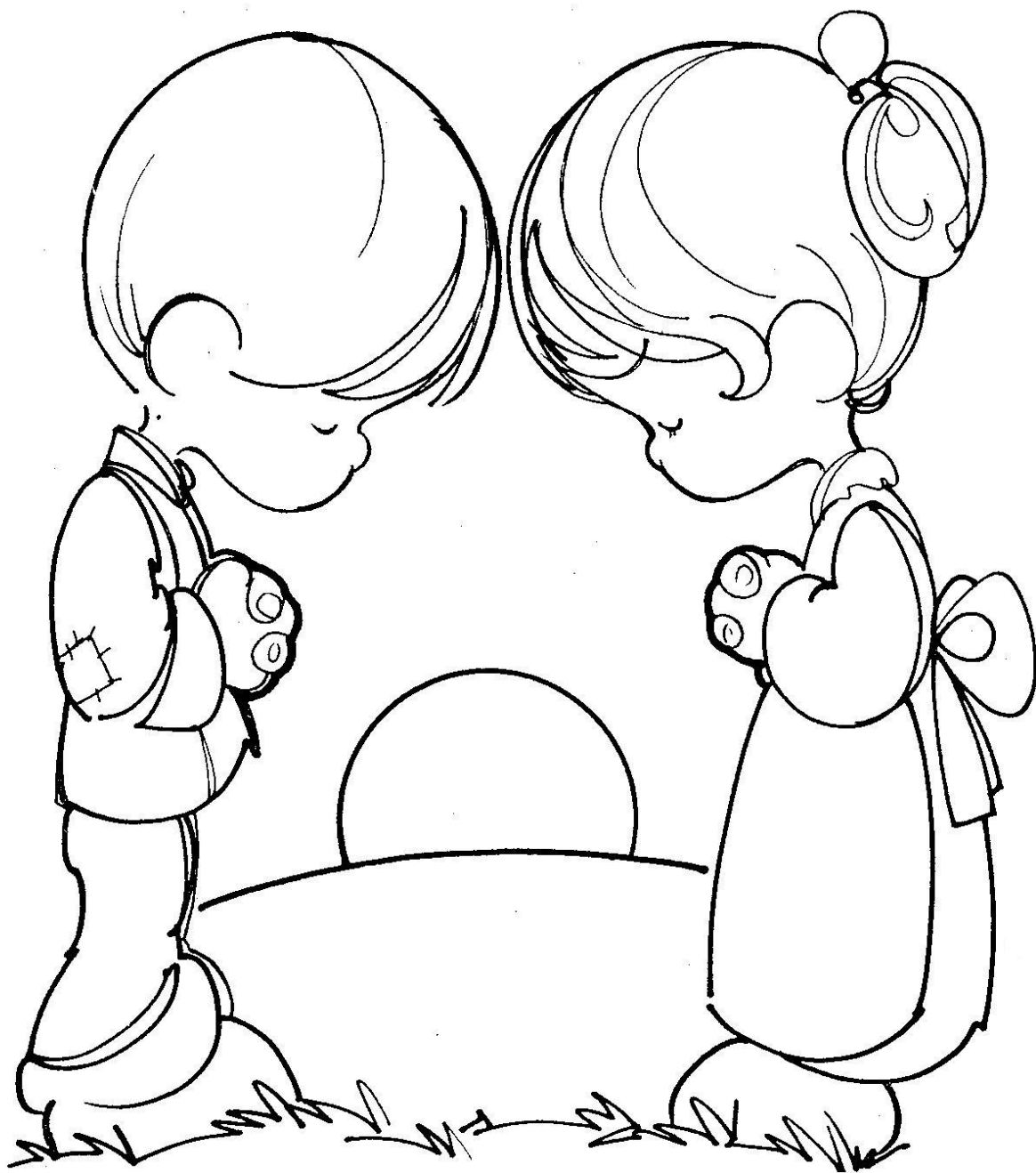
