

## RELATIONSHIP TIME WITH OUR HEAVENLY FATHER

The following are suggestions which you can incorporate into your relationship building time with God. Don't feel you have to cover each point. Be flexible as the Holy Spirit leads and guides you during this time. You may find as you grow in this time that you develop other items which can be added to the list.

\* It's always good to come into your quiet time focusing on who and what God is to you..being thankful for the day and the opportunity to serve Him.

\* Ask questions of the Lord.

\* Hold discussions with God.

\* Don't be afraid to tell God your feelings (He knows anyway).

\* Ask God what He wants to say to you. You don't need to do all the talking. It is important to learn to listen and to recognize His voice speaking to you.

\* Make worship a part of your time.

\* As you study the Word, use a concordance and other tools. If you don't know how to use these, ask someone to teach you.

\* Personalize the Scriptures you read and study.

\* Look up key words.

\* Target an area of your life for spiritual growth. This can often be a good area for study as well.

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## ACCOUNTABILITY QUESTIONS

These are a few questions you can use as you meet with those you are discipling. Don't feel you have to cover all of them in one meeting time.

1. Tell me about your current relationship building time.
2. Describe your prayer life.
3. How are you presently experiencing transformation?
4. Tell me how you are feeling about yourself, about life?
5. What are you specifically doing to deepen your study in the Word?
6. Share a revelation from your time with God this week.
7. How can I pray for you?
8. How have you repented this week?
9. Is there anyone you need to forgive (past or present)?

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
