

## TEACH...ALL THAT JESUS COMMANDED

### Matthew 28:19, 20



As part of the discipleship process, Jesus said we were to teach to those being disciplined, all that He had commanded. As we look through the Gospels, the following is a list of a few of these things that can be the focus of discipleship as you teach others. Other Scriptures which apply to these can be added to those in this list. As you use these to teach others, it would be beneficial to apply Christ's command to our everyday lives. That's living out the Gospel.

1. To enter the kingdom, we must be born again: John 3:5-7
2. Repent and believe: Matthew 4:17; Mark 1:15
3. Be baptized: Acts 2:38, Matthew 28:19
4. Deny self and follow Christ: Matthew 16:24; Matthew 19:21; John 12:26
5. Be a witness/let your light shine: Matthew 5:16
6. Love your enemies and pray for them: Matthew 5:44-45; Proverbs 25:21, 22;  
Luke 6:27-28; 35
7. Honor and do not do away with God's laws: Matthew 5:17-19
8. Reconcile with those who have something against you or to whom you have anger/resentment: Matthew 5:21-26
9. Do not commit adultery: Exodus 20:14; Matthew 5:27-32
10. Keep vows and oaths (telling the truth): Matthew 5:33-37; Matthew 23:16; Ephesians 4:25
11. Don't seek revenge/retaliation: Matthew 5:38-44
12. Be perfect/growing into complete maturity: Matthew 5:48; Deuteronomy 18:13
13. Don't do acts of goodness/kindness/your works to be for appearance only/to be seen by others: Matthew 6:1-4
14. Regarding prayer: Not to impress others (and correct way to pray): Matthew 6:5-13
15. Forgive others: Matthew 6:14-15; Matthew 18:21-22
16. Lay up your treasures in heaven and not on earth: Matthew 6:19-24; Luke 12:15-21; Luke 18:24; John 6:27
17. Don't worry or be anxious: Matthew 6:25-32
18. Seek God's kingdom first: Matthew 6:33
19. Love your neighbor as yourself: Matthew 22:39; Mark 12:31; Romans 13:10
20. Love God with all your heart, soul, and mind: Matthew 22:39
21. Honor your father and mother: Matthew 19:19; Matthew 15:4
22. Do not judge, criticize, and condemn others: Matthew 7:1-5; Luke 6:37; Romans 2:1

23. Do not cast pearls (give what is holy) before haters of truth and righteousness: Matthew 7:6
24. Ask, seek, and knock: Matthew 7:7-8; Matthew 7:11
25. Do unto others: Matthew 7:12; Luke 6:31
26. Hearing Christ's words and doing them is wise: Matthew 7:24-27; James 1:22
27. Pray for laborers to the harvest: Matthew 9:38; Luke 10:2
28. Take His yoke and learn from Him: Matthew 11:29
29. The one who loves God keeps His commands: John 14:15; John 14:21-24; John 5:10-14
30. Don't despise the little ones: Matthew 18:10; Matthew 18:6
31. Beware of any greed/covetousness: Luke 12:15; Hebrews 13:5
32. His teaching regarding marriage and divorce: Matthew 19:4-9; Romans 7:2;

40. Two commissions: We are to follow Christ as we feed and shepherd the sheep: John
