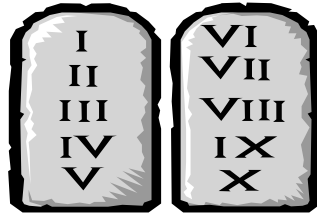


# TEN COMMANDMENTS

Number	Commandment	References	Related Scriptures and Topics
1	You shall have <b>no</b> other gods before Me (no other gods)	Exodus 20:3 Deuteronomy 5:7	Deut. 31:16-18,20 Deut. 32:16-17 2 Kings 17:7-12; 15-18 –Turning to other gods
			Matt. 10:37-38; Luke 14:26-27: God (and His Son) Must come first, not allowing anyone or anything to come before Him
			Lev. 10:3 Matthew 6:9 – Regarding God as holy
			Lev. 11:44-45 1 Peter 1:14-16 – Becoming holy as God is holy
2	You shall not make for yourself a carved image You shall not bow down to them nor serve them (no idols)	Exodus 20:4-6 Deuteronomy 5:8-10	Deut. 4:15-19 – Acting corruptly to make images (idols)
			Deut. 4:23 – Forgetting God's covenant to make carved images
			Deut. 27:15 – Curse upon idol maker
			Isaiah 44:13-20 – Foolishness of the idol maker
3	You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain	Exodus 20:7 Deuteronomy 5:11	Lev. 18:21 – You shall not profane the name of God
			Lev. 19:12 – You shall not swear by God's name falsely nor profane His name.
			Matthew 6:9: Hold the Name of God in the highest reverence and holiness

4	Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.	Exodus 20:8-11 Deuteronomy 5:12-15	Genesis 2:2-3: God Himself rested from His work on the 7 <sup>th</sup> day (He had no need to do so but did for an example for us). He blessed and sanctified the 7 <sup>th</sup> day.
			Exodus 31:13-17: Terms of the covenant of the Sabbath
			Leviticus 19:30 and Leviticus 26:2: Observe God's Sabbaths
			Isaiah 56:1-8: Blessings upon the one who keeps from defiling the Sabbath
			Isaiah 58:13-14: Calling the Sabbath a delight

### OUR RELATIONSHIP TO PARENTS

Number	Commandment	Reference	Related Scriptures and Topics
5	Honor your father and your mother.  The reward for keeping this commandment is long life and a good life. (Deut. 5:16)	Exodus 20:12  Deuteronomy 5:16	Exodus 21:17; Leviticus 20:9: Everyone who <u>curses</u> his father or mother shall be put to death. Mark 7:10
			Proverbs 20:20: Whoever <u>curses</u> father or mother will be blind (spiritually, maybe physically)
			Leviticus 19:3: Everyone must <u>revere</u> his father and his mother.
			Proverbs 23:22: Listen to your biological (natural) father and do not despise your aged mother.
			Ephesians 6:1-3: Obey parents and honor father and mother for good and long life.

Number	Commandment	Reference	Related Scriptures and Topics
6	You shall not murder	Exodus 20:13  Deuteronomy 5:17	Genesis 4:1-8: 1 John 3:12 Hebrews 11:4: Cain murdered his brother Abel because his own works were evil and Abel's righteous.
			2 Samuel 3:30: Joab and Abishai killed Abner who had killed their brother Asahel
			2 Samuel 11:14-17: David ordered Joab to place Uriah in a dangerous place so to be killed in battle
			2 Samuel 13:28-29: Absalom had Amnon killed in order to gain vengeance for raping his sister Tamar
			Matthew 5:21-22: Jesus redefines murder
7	You shall not commit adultery	Exodus 20:14  Deuteronomy 5:18	Deuteronomy 22:22: The penalty for adultery is death to both the man and woman who sinned in this manner.
			2 Samuel 11:1-4: David committed adultery with Bathsheba (wife of Uriah)
			Matthew 5:27-28, 31-32: Jesus redefines adultery
8	You shall not steal.	Exodus 20:15  Deuteronomy 5:19	Exodus 22:1: Whoever <u>steals</u> an ox or sheep must make severe <u>restitution</u> : 5 oxen for an ox and 4 sheep for a sheep (other stolen animals or goods have varying penalties of restitution)
9	You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.	Exodus 20:16  Deuteronomy 5:20	Exodus 23:1: "You shall <u>not</u> circulate a false report
			Prov. 11:13 & 20:19 – talebearer
			Psalm 101:5: "Whoever secretly slanders his neighbor, him I will destroy..."
			You shall not take a stand (falsely) against the life of your neighbor: Lev. 19:16      1 Kings 21:7-13 Psalm 35:11      Matthew 26:59-66
			Matthew 28:11-15 (paid false witnesses) about Jesus' resurrection
			Prov. 19:9 A false witness will be punished:

Number	Commandment	Reference	Related Scriptures and Topics
10	You shall not covet anything belonging to your neighbor.	Exodus 20:17	Romans 7:7: We do not know what sin is except by the Law: covetousness is identified here by the Apostle Paul.
	If your neighbor has something you want but will not sell it to you, cut off your desire for it or it will cause you to covet.	Deuteronomy 5:21	Exodus 18:21 1 Timothy 3:3: Leaders must not be covetous
			Joshua 7:1-26: Achan was covetous at Jericho.
			2 Samuel 11:1-4: David coveted Bathsheba to have her.
			Matthew 19:16-22: The rich young ruler was too covetous of his great possessions to sell them and give the proceeds to the poor as Jesus told him to do.
			Luke 12:13-21: The rich farmer was much too covetous of his very plentiful crop to even think of sharing it with others. He could think only of building more storage space to retain the entire crop for himself.
